## US CUSTOMS IMMIGRATION INFORMATION

You will need to provide the following documentation: If you are a Canadian citizen:

- A passport and photo identification
- Birth certificate
- Work visa or I-94 multiple entry for you and your family
- Social insurance number
- A 3299 form

If you are returning to the United States:

- Passport and photo identification
- Birth certificate
- Social security number
- A 3299 form

## If it is an Estate move:

- Notarized letter from the Trustee of the Estate
- Death Certificate
- A 3299 from filled out in the name if the US resident

If you are sending a vehicle to the United States, it will need to meet the specifications of the US Federal Emission Standards and the US Federal Safety Standards.

## Simplified Guide to Completing the 3299 Form when moving to the United States

**Part I:** (To be filled in by the person whose name will be on the shipment)

- 1. Name in full, no initials.
- 2. Date of Birth.
- 3. Date of entry into the US must precede the arrival of the shipment.
- 4. Delivery address in the US if unknown, show a contact address.
- 5. Port at which you enter the US.
- 6. Means by which you enter the US, i.e. automobile, Air Canada, etc.
- 7. Names must be entered in full, noting the relationship of each member to you.
- 8. a) Date the shipment arrives at the border to be completed by the driver
  - b) Company to be completed by the driver
  - c) Canada
  - d) Order number to be completed by the driver
  - e) Number of items being shipped to be completed by the driver
  - f) Inventory tags listed here to be completed by the driver.

**Part II:** (completed by the person whose name will be on the shipment)

- 9. a) Canada
  - b) Length of time you resided in Canada
  - c) Note whatever is applicable to you:
    - \*\* Returning US resident, enter social security number
    - \*\* Non-resident, enter visa or passport number
- 10. Whatever is applicable to you.

**Part III:** (This section is completed if you are with the US government)

**Part IV:** (Note in appropriate box, if applicable)

11. If this section is completed, US Customs will probably assess duty and you must complete section D on the reverse.

**Part V:** (Origin member completes this section)

Part VI: Completed as per PART I & PART II

- 14. Date the document is completed

## Please remember:

- If you are an American citizen, you MUST put your Social Security number on the top of the 3299 form.
- If you are a Non-Resident of the US, you MUST put your visa/passport number on the top of the 3299 form.
